## GRANT DEED

FOR A VALUABLE CONSIDERATION, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, BOMBAY BEACH COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT, acting by and through its Committee, pursuant to a duly adopted resolution, does hereby grant to NILAND FIRE DISTRICT the following described real property, located in the County of Imperial, State of California:

Lots 34 and 35, in Block "C" of Bombay Beach Tract, in the County of Imperial, State of California, according to Map No. 317, on file in the office of the County Recorder of Imperial County.

SUBJECT TO: Covenants, conditions, restrictions, reservations, easements, and rights of way of record; and

## SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- 1. The Grantee shall furnish a building and equipment on these premises to be used as a fire station within one year from the date of execution of this deed.
  - 2. Said real property shall be used for fire station purposes.
- 3. In the event such a building and equipment are not furnished on said premises within one year from the date of execution of this deed, the Bombay Beach Community Services District shall have the right to re-enter and take possession of said property at the expiration of ninety (90) days from the receipt by the Board of the Niland Fire District, of written notice from said

period the failure of use of said property, as specified in said notice, shall not have been remedied.

- 4. If at any time after said use has commenced the property shall cease to be used for fire station purposes, the Bombay Beach Community Services District shall have the right to re-enter and take possession of said property at the expiration of ninety (90) days from the receipt by the Board of the Niland Fire District, of written notice from said Bombay Beach Community Services District of its intent to so re-enter, and the reasons therefor, during which ninety (90) day period the cessation of use of said property, as specified in said notice, shall not have been remedied. This right to re-enter and take possession of said property by the Bombay Beach Community Services District upon cessation of use is further conditioned by the requirement that the Bombay Beach Community Services District upon the Bombay Beach community Services District pay the Niland Fire District at the end of said ninety (90) day period the depreciated value of the building and fixtures upon the formula hereinafter set forth:
  - a. The depreciated value shall be determined by subtracting ten (10%) per cent per year of the construction cost of any permanent improvement added to or on the land by the Niland Fire District as determined by the records of the Auditor of the County of Imperial from and at the time of acceptance of any such improvement by the Board of the Niland Fire District.
- b. If the Niland Fire District should abandon said property of their own will, we would have the right to buy or reject the building.
