## A RESOLUTION OF THE HOLTVILLE PLANNING COMMISSION CERTIFYING A NEGATIVE DECLARATION (ND) FOR THE OSBORNE JURISDICTIONAL CHANGES, GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT AND PRE-ZONE, UNDER ANNEXATION HV3-15

WHEREAS, The City of Holtville was approached by Donald R. Osborne and Donna J. Osborne owners ("Applicants/Permittees") of APN's 045-330-071 & 045-340-029 portions of which are being proposed to be annexed and detached under the proposed Annexation HV3-15 Jurisdictional Changes, General Plan Amendment, and Pre-Zone, hereafter referred as "Project"; and

**NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED,** that the Planning Commission of the City of Holtville determines as follows:

- A) That the foregoing recitations are true and correct; and
- B) That based on the evidence presented at the public hearing, the Planning Commission hereby <u>CERTIFIES</u> the Negative Declaration for the proposed Annexation HV3-15 Osborne Jurisdictional Changes, General Plan Amendment, and Pre-Zone affecting APN's 045-330-071 & 045-340-029 and based on the following findings:
  - That the project has been reviewed in accordance with the requirements set forth by The City of Holtville for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act.
  - That the project is in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act, Section 2100 through 21176 of the Public Resources Code.
  - That the proposed draft Negative Declaration shows that any
