RESOLUTION OF THE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION OF THE COUNTY OF IMPERIAL MAKING A DETERMINATION AND APPROVING AN EXTENSION OF WATER FROM THE HEBER PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT TO CLEAN ENERGY ADVANTAGE (HPUD 1-22).

RESOLVED by the Local Agency Formation Commission of Imperial, State of California, that

WHEREAS a proposal to extend Water service to Clean Energy Advantage for the cleaning of solar panels at Mount Signal Solar 1 was filed on March 14, 2022, with this Commission and the Executive Officer of this Commission pursuant to Title 5, Division 3, commencing with Section 56133 of the Government Code; and

WHEREAS the Executive Officer determined the application complete; and

WHEREAS the Extension of Water service is outside the Heber Public Utility Districts service area; and

WHEREAS the applicant will utilize the water for the cleaning of solar panels at Mount Signal Solar 1 located in Calexico, CA; and

WHEREAS the Heber Public Utility District authorized the extension of Water service for the proposed project; and

WHEREAS the Executive Officer has been delegated the authority by the Commission to review and approve this type of project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DETERMINED, that the Local Agency Formation Commission by decision of the Executive Officer does find as follows:

- I. Authorize the Heber Public Utility District to extend Temporary Water service to Clean Energy Advantage for the cleaning of solar panels at Mount Signal Solar 1.
- II. The extension of Water service is limited to the proposed project, and the water will be trucked from HPUD to the project site located in Calexico, CA.
- III. The Applicant/District shall provide to LAFCO the following items in order to complete the processing of the extension:
 - i. Authorization by Heber Public Utility District approving the Extension of Water.
 - ii. The District shall provide the total amount of gallons used upon completion.

IV. The District is authorized to provide an Extension of Water Service solely to Clean Energy Advantage one (1) more time within the next three years. The District shall provide to LAFCO a notice to extend water service and final report.

INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

As part of this application, applicant and real party in interest, if different, agree to defend, indemnify, hold harmless, and release the Imperial County Local Agency Formation Commission, its agents, officers, attorneys, and employees (including consultants) from any claim, action, or proceeding brought against any of them, the purpose of which is to attack, set aside, void, or annul the approval of this application or adoption of the environmental document which accompanies it. This indemnification obligation shall include, but not be limited to, damages, costs, expenses, attorney fees, or expert witness fees that may be asserted by any person or entity, including the applicant, arising out of or in connection with the approval of this application, whether or not there is concurrent negligence on the part of the Imperial County Local Agency Formation Commission, its agents, officers, attorneys, or employees (including consultants).

If any claim, action, or proceeding is brought against Imperial County Local Agency Formation Commission, its agents, officers, attorneys, or employees, to attack, set aside, void, or annul the approval of the application or adoption of the environmental document which accompanies it, then the following procedures shall apply:

- 1. The Executive Officer shall promptly notify the Commission of any claim, action or proceeding brought by an applicant challenging the Commission's action. The Commission, its agents, attorneys and employees (including consultants) shall fully cooperate in the defense of that action.
- The Commission shall have final determination on how to best defend the case and may defend it with inhouse counsel, or by retaining outside counsel. In either case applicant shall be fully responsible for all costs incurred. Applicant may request to provide his or her own counsel to defend the case, however prior written approval of the Commission shall be obtained. Said independent counsel shall work with LAFCO counsel to provide a joint defense and shall include a complete defense of LAFCO to the satisfaction of the Commission.
