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# LEASE AGREEMENT

THIS LEASE AGREEMENT (hereinafter "LEASE"), made and entered into this 3 day of August, 1996, by and between SEELEY COUNTY WATER DISTRICT, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter "LESSOR", and the County of Imperial, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter "LESSEE", shall be as follows:

#### RECITALS

WHEREAS, LESSOR is the record owner of certain real property identified in Paragraph number 1 herein with improvements thereon which it desires to lease to LESSEE; and

WHEREAS, LESSEE seeks to lease the subject property from LESSOR; and

WHEREAS, LESSOR and LESSEE are desirous of entering into an agreement to lease the subject property; and

WHEREAS, LESSOR and LESSEE are desirous of establishing a staffed fire fighting facility in the township of Seeley, California; and

WHEREAS, LESSOR seeks to have LESSEE operate and maintain the park currently located on the subject property; and

WHEREAS, this LEASE is entered into with the understanding that LESSEE shall during its term provide fire service to the township of Seeley and operate and maintain the park currently located on the property to be leased; and

WHEREAS, the subject property shall be used exclusively by LESSEE for fire protection services and a park; and

WHEREAS, LESSOR and LESSEE intend this LEASE to supersede that certain lease dated January 7, 1992, by and between SEELEY COUNTY WATER DISTRICT and COUNTY OF IMPERIAL and which is due to expire on July 31, 1996.

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WITNESSETH

That in consideration of the payment of the rents and the performance of all the terms and conditions herein contained, LESSOR does hereby lease to LESSEE the following described premises on the terms and conditions herein recited.

# LEASED PREMISES

The property which is the subject of this LEASE is described as Block 15, Crabtree Addition, Townsite of Seeley, California and which includes certain improvements, namely a preengineered metal wall building whose exterior dimension is 40 feet Х 75 feet, together with an enclosed fenced equipment/storage yard, all of which is located at the southeast corner of said Block 15, at the intersection of Park St. and San Diego Ave., hereinafter referred to as the "PREMISES".

# PARTIES TO LEASE

2.1. This LEASE is by and between LESSOR and LESSEE. LESSOR and LESSEE are sometimes hereinafter collectively referred to as "PARTIES".

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2.2. It is not the intent of the PARTIES to this LEASE to create, and nothing in this LEASE shall be construed as creating, a joint venture or partnership or any other relationship between the PARTIES other than that of lessor and lessee. Neither LESSOR nor LESSEE authorizes the other to act as its agent or representative.

#### З. LEASE OF THE PREMISES.

LESSOR leases to LESSEE, and LESSEE leases from LESSOR the PREMISES for the term, at the rental, and upon all of the terms and conditions set forth herein.

#### TERM.

- 4.1. The term of this LEASE shall be for five (5) years, commencing August 1, 1996, and ending July 31, 2001.
- 4.2. Provided LESSEE is not in default of the terms of this LEASE, it shall have the option to extend the term of this LEASE for three (3) additional consecutive periods of five (5) years each upon the same terms and conditions.
- 4.3. Written notice to extend the term of this LEASE must be mailed to LESSOR at least thirty (30) days prior to the expiration date of the original LEASE term or option term(s), whichever the case may be.

#### 5. RENT.

During the term of this LEASE, LESSEE shall pay rent to LESSOR in the amount of One Dollar (\$1.00) per year as consideration for LESSEE's provision of fire protection services and park operation and maintenance.

# 6. USE OF PREMISES.

LESSEE shall use the PREMISES only for the operation of a park and fire fighting and rescue services in the Townsite of Seeley and other unincorporated areas nearby.

#### 7. UTILITIES.

- 7.1. LESSOR shall pay all charges for electricity, water, and sewer services furnished to that portion of the PREMISES used for the park during the term of this LEASE and shall agree to hold LESSEE harmless for any costs related thereto.
- 7.2. LESSEE shall pay all charges for gas, electricity, water, sewer, telephone and trash removal services furnished to that portion of the PREMISES used to operate and maintain the fire station during the term of this LEASE and shall agree to hold LESSOR harmless for any costs related thereto.

# 8. MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR.

LESSEE shall be responsible to perform all maintenance necessary to operate the PREMISES in compliance with all rules and regulations as enforced by the appropriate building inspection authority. However, LESSOR shall be responsible for any and all costs related to structural repairs of the existing improvements located thereon and/or constructed by LESSOR or its employees, agents contractors or subcontractors.

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9.1. Title to improvements. All right, title and interest to improvements or facilities which are permanently affixed to the PREMISES shall vest in LESSOR upon the termination or expiration of this LEASE. However, LESSEE shall have the right to remove any equipment or facilities not permanently affixed to the PREMISES where such removal can be done without damaging the PREMISES, upon the termination or expiration of this LEASE. LESSEE may install in the PREMISES, furniture, equipment machinery necessary to meet the uses intended by this LESSEE's trade fixtures shall be and remain the personal property of LESSEE, which LESSEE may replace and remove during the term of this LEASE, and which LESSEE shall remove at the termination of this LEASE. LESSEE, at its sole cost and expense, shall repair all damage to the PREMISES which installation, replacement or removal of the trade fixtures may cause.

9.2. LESSEE shall not make any major alterations or improvements to the PREMISES without obtaining LESSOR's written consent of the plans and specifications. A major alteration or improvement is one which costs more than \$10,000.00. LESSOR shall not unreasonably withhold its consent.

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- '9.3. LESSOR shall have 30 working days from receipt of the plans and specifications to approve or reject, in whole or in part, such plans and specifications. The failure of the LESSOR to reject the plans and specifications within working days from their receipt shall constitute acceptance of the submitted plans and specifications.
- 9.4. If the LESSOR rejects such plans and specifications, in whole or in part, the LESSOR shall notify LESSEE in writing of such rejection, and the reasons therefor.
- 9.5. LESSEE shall not be required to purchase or replace any playground equipment for the park.
- 9.6. LESSOR shall at its sole cost and expense purchase a sprinkler system to serve the entire park. The type of sprinkler system to be purchased must meet with the written consent of LESSEE who shall at its sole cost and expense install the same.

#### 10. ENTRY AND INSPECTION BY LESSOR.

LESSOR reserves the right to inspect the PROPERTY to determine if the covenants of this LEASE are being properly performed. However, prior to inspecting any structures or improvements located thereon, LESSOR must provide LESSEE with reasonable notice of the same and be given LESSEE'S written consent to perform the inspection. Said written consent shall not be unreasonably withheld by LESSEE.

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## 11. HOLD HARMLESS.

During the term of this LEASE, LESSEE agrees to hold LESSOR, its Board of Directors, and each member thereof, and its agents, servants and employees, harmless from and against any and all claims arising from LESSEE's use of the PREMISES, or from the conduct of LESSEE's business on the PREMISES, except to the extent that such claim is the result of LESSOR, its Board of Directors, agents, servants or employees willful or negligent conduct. By entering into this LEASE, LESSEE in no way whatsoever waives any defenses that it might have, including sovereign immunity, and all other defenses that it has concerning fire fighting services or operating and maintaining a park.

# 12. ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE.

- 12.1 LESSOR shall be liable for and indemnify LESSEE from environmental cleanup costs or other similar expenses, imposed upon LESSEE arising from environmental contamination of the PREMISES caused by LESSOR.
- 12.2 LESSEE shall be liable for and indemnify LESSOR from environmental cleanup costs or other similar expenses, imposed upon LESSEE arising from environmental contamination of the PREMISES caused by LESSEE.

# 13. INSURANCE.

- or extended term thereof, that it shall be self-insured to the extent of \$200,000.00 per claim, per the self-insured retention concept, after which LESSEE's excess insurance coverage policy takes effect to a limit of \$10 million. LESSEE shall name LESSOR as an additional insured on its excess insurance policy so that coverage is provided LESSOR.
- 13.2 LESSEE, hereby agrees at its sole cost and expense, to also obtain and maintain in full force during the entire term of this LEASE and any extended term thereof Fire insurance in an amount not less than the certified cost of the fire station structure. Said coverage shall include the full replacement for the fire station structure in the event of loss, damage or destruction by fire.
- 13.3 Additional Insurance. Nothing in this, or any other provision of this LEASE, shall be construed to preclude LESSOR or LESSEE from obtaining and maintaining any additional insurance policies in addition to those required pursuant to this LEASE.

- 14.1. LESSEE's Obligation to Restore. If there is damage to the fire station structure located on the subject PREMISES from any cause, the cost of repairing which is fully covered by insurance, LESSEE shall promptly restore the fire station structure, to approximately the predamaged condition; provided that such restoration can be completed within sixty (60) days after that date of casualty.
- 14.2. LESSEE's Option to Restore. If there is damage to the fire station structure which is uninsured, or not fully insured, or if restoration of any fully insured damage to the fire station structure cannot be completed within the sixty (60) day period set forth above, or if the fire station structure is totally destroyed, then, in any such case, LESSEE may elect to terminate this LEASE or elect to restore the same to its prior condition. LESSEE shall notify LESSOR of its election in writing within seven (7) days after the date of casualty. If LESSEE elects to restore, LESSEE shall promptly restore the fire station structure. If LESSEE elects to terminate this LEASE it shall terminate as of the date of casualty, and the PARTIES shall have no further obligations under the LEASE except for obligations which arose prior to or at the time of the casualty unless LESSOR elects to restore the fire station structure pursuant to Paragraph 14.4.

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14.3. Restoration. If LESSEE undertakes to restore the fire station structure pursuant to Paragraphs 14.1 and/or 14.2, or if LESSOR undertakes to restore the fire station structure pursuant to Paragraph 14.4, this LEASE shall remain in full force and effect. Rent shall abate from the date of casualty in the proportion that LESSEE is actually deprived of use of the fire station structure, unless the damage is the result of the negligence or willful misconduct of LESSEE.

14.4. LESSOR's Right to Restore. LESSOR may prevent LESSEE's election to terminate pursuant to Paragraph 14.2 and elect to restore the fire station structure, provided such restoration can be completed within sixty (60) days of receipt of the LESSEE's notice of termination and LESSOR provides LESSEE written notice of its election to restore within seven (7) days after receipt of LESSEE's notice of termination. If LESSOR elects to restore the fire station structure, LESSOR shall solely responsible for full restoration of the same to its condition prior to the damage or destruction, including the cost thereof. If LESSOR elects to restore the fire station structure, it shall, first obtain LESSEE's written approval of the plans and specifications, which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld.

14.5 Paragraph 14 shall not apply to any other existing structures located on the subject PREMISES.

# 15. ASSIGNMENT.

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- 15.1 Neither this LEASE nor any rights, duties or obligations hereunder shall be assignable by either Party without the prior written consent of the other Party.
- assurances, modification of this LEASE, or such other requirements as Party in its sole discretion deems advisable, as a condition to granting its consent to any assignee hereunder. Nothing herein shall be construed as requiring a Party to grant such approval if that Party, in its sole opinion, deems such grant of consent to be not in the best interests of the Party.
- 15.3 Consent by a Party to an assignment shall not release the assigning Party from its primary liability under this AGREEMENT, and a Party's consent to one assignment, shall not be deemed a consent to other assignments.

# 16. BINDING.

This LEASE shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the heirs, successors and assigns of the Parties hereto.

## 17. DEFAULT

17.1. LESSOR's Default. If LESSOR fails or refuses to perform any provision, covenant or condition to be kept or performed by LESSOR under this LEASE, LESSEE, prior to exercising any of its rights or remedies, shall give written notice to LESSOR of such default, specifying in said notice the nature of such default and LESSOR shall have thirty (30)

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days from receipt of such notice to cure said default. If such default is not cured within said thirty (30) day period, then LESSEE may in its sole discretion terminate this LEASE and/or pursue those remedies available under the law at the time this LEASE is executed as well as any future remedies that are created.

17.2. LESSEE's Default. If LESSEE fails or refuses to perform any provision, covenant or condition to be kept or performed by LESSEE under this LEASE. LESSOR, prior to exercising any of its rights or remedies, shall give written notice to LESSEE of such default, specifying in said notice the nature of such default and LESSEE shall have thirty (30) days from receipt of such notice to cure said default. If such default is not cured within said thirty (30) day period, then LESSOR may in its sole discretion terminate this LEASE and/or pursue those remedies available under the law at the time this LEASE is executed as well as any future remedies that are created.

# 18. SURRENDER OF PREMISES

LESSEE agrees to and shall, on expiration or sooner termination of the term thereof promptly surrender and deliver the PREMISES to LESSOR in good condition, ordinary wear and tear excepted.

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## 19. AMENDMENTS

No modification, waiver, amendment, discharge, or change of this LEASE shall be valid unless the same is in writing and signed by the party against whom the enforcement of such modification, waiver, amendment, discharge, or change is or may be sought.

# 20. GOVERNING LAW

This LEASE shall be governed by the laws of the State of California. This LEASE is made and entered into in Imperial County, California. Any action brought by either party with respect to this LEASE shall be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction within said County.

## 21. NOTICES.

Any notice by either party to the other shall be personally delivered to the party or sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, to the addresses set forth below, or to such other addresses as either party may from time to time notify the other in writing.

#### 22. ENTIRE LEASE.

This LEASE contains the entire contract between LESSOR and LESSEE relating to the transactions contemplated hereby and supersedes all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, provisions, negotiations, representations, or statements, either written or oral, including, but not limited to that certain lease dated January 7, 1992, by and between the Seeley County Water District and County of Imperial.

# 23. MODIFICATION.

No modification, waiver, amendment, discharge, or change of this LEASE shall be valid unless the same is in writing and signed by the Party against who the enforcement of such modification, waiver, amendment, discharge, or change is or may be sought.

## 24. CAPTIONS.

Captions in this LEASE are inserted for convenience of reference only and do not define, describe or limit the scope or the intent of this LEASE or any of the terms thereof.

#### 25. PARTIAL INVALIDITY.

If any provision in this LEASE is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will nevertheless continue in full force without being impaired or invalidated in any way.

### 26. WAIVER.

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No waiver of any breach or of any of the covenants or conditions of this LEASE shall be construed to be a waiver of any other breach or to be a consent to any further or succeeding breach of the same or any other covenant or condition.

## 27. ATTORNEY'S FEES.

If either party herein brings an action to enforce the terms thereof or declare rights hereunder, the prevailing party in any such action, on trial or appeal, shall be entitled to its reasonable attorney's fees to be paid by the losing party as fixed by the court.

#### 28. GENDER AND INTERPRETATION OF TERMS AND PROVISIONS.

As used in this LEASE and whenever required by the context thereof, each number, both singular or plural, shall include all numbers, and each gender shall include both genders. LESSOR as used in this LEASE or in any other document referred to in or made a part of this LEASE shall likewise include both singular and the plural, a corporation, a partnership, individual, firm or person acting in any fiduciary capacity as executor, administrator, trustee in or other representative capacity or any other entity. All covenants herein contained on the part of the LESSOR shall be joint and several if more than one person, firm or entity executes the LEASE.

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# 29. AUTHORITY.

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Each of the individual's executing this AGREEMENT on behalf of LESSOR and LESSEE represent and warrant that:

- 29.1 He/She is duly authorized to execute and deliver this AGREEMENT on behalf of LESSOR or LESSEE as applicable; and
- 29.2 Such execution and delivery on behalf of the Parties is duly authorized by the legislature and executive of each party and is within the power and authority of the signatory as granted by such body or executive of the same.
- 29.3 This LEASE is binding upon the respective Parties in accordance with its terms.

# 30. COUNTERPARTS.

This LEASE may be executed in counterparts.

# 31. REVIEW OF LEASE TERMS.

This LEASE has been reviewed and revised by legal counsel for both LESSOR and LESSEE, and no presumption or rule that ambiguities shall be construed against the drafting party shall apply to the interpretation or enforcement of the same or any subsequent amendments thereto.
